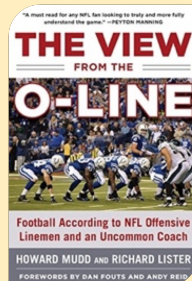
## Some common phrases a mediator will hear

## Cinnabon Style Cinnamon Rolls



- Bridgeford Premade Frozen Dough (thawed)
- Roll out on flour covered surface to 1/8<sup>th</sup> inch thickness
- Cover liberally with margarine, then layer on baker's sugar, brown sugar and cinnamon
- Roll and cut into five pieces. Place in oiled round glass baking dish
- Let rise for three hours
- Bake at 350° for 18 minutes
- Remove from oven and let cool for 15 minutes
- Place on serving plate and liberally apply a can of sour cream frosting
